Instrument for exchange of Medical students

This instrument is between

the UNIVERSIDAD DE CHILE, Santiago, Chile

and

KAROLINSKA INSTITUTET, the Medical University of Stockholm, Sweden

with respect to an exchange programme between the two institutions for Medical Degree students.

The following terms will apply for the exchange of Medical Degree students.

Both institutions will

- share information on a regular basis through an international office or an exchange coordinator on courses and other educational activities as well as on experiences of the exchange*
- recognize that the academic credit of the studies abroad is the responsibility of the degree granting institution and the requirements for documentation should be specified before starting the studies*
- recognize that no tuition or administration fees will be charged to visiting students or sending institutions*
- recognize that the host institution will be responsible for necessary local insurance fees for the visiting students*
- recognize that the time of exchange for each student shall not be less than 2 months of study and must not exceed a period of 12 months*

Sending institution will

- select students for exchange which have commenced their education at the host institution at the relevant faculties and thus are well known to faculty members
- in due time before the beginning of the semester inform the host institution upon the study requests by students selected for exchange
- discuss with the students the possible needs for vaccinations or other health measures in connection with the visit abroad


Host institution will

- when possible with respect to practical circumstances, accept the expected students to participate in the desired course or elective, or an agreeable alternative, on equal terms with other students
- help the visiting students with educational and practical information prior to their arrival and assist the students in finding a suitable accommodation
- see the students upon arrival to discuss objectives and goals, and again before leaving, in agreement that evaluation is essential to the success of the exchange programme
- at or soon after leaving of the students, supply the sending institution with detailed information on the type and amount of studies the students have taken part of, any formal tests the students have passed, as well as other information of value to the sending institution in order to help the evaluation and recognition of the academic credit of the students foreign experience

This agreement is subject to the same enforcement conditions as the established instrument on cooperative planning. The term of duration of this agreement shall be of five (5) years and it shall be renewed for equal periods, unless one of the parties notifies in writing to the other of its desire to terminate such agreement at least three (3) months prior to the date of termination.
